

ABSTRACT

Early childhood (0-6 years) often experience various forms of physical, verbal, mental and sexual violence which can disrupt their development. Malang Regency DP3A data for 2023 records that the number of victims of sexual violence against children has doubled due to a lack of understanding and sexual education for children from an early age. This research aims to develop the Answer and Jump game as an educational medium to prevent sexual harassment in children aged 4-5 years. The development of the Answer and Jump game was designed based on the shortcomings and improvements of previous media, namely leaflet and image media. The method used is R&D research with 10 step development procedures, (1) Potential and Problems, (2) Data Collection, (3) Product Design, (4) Design Validation, (5) Design Revision, (6) Product Trial, (7) Product Revision, (8) Usage Trial, (9) Product Revision, (10) Mass Production. Of these 10 steps, researchers carried out step 7 with a sample of 18 children aged 4-5 years at the Mutiara Bunda PAUD Post, Malang City. The research instrument uses a product assessment questionnaire. The research results showed that the media developed was categorized as very feasible, with assessments from material experts (92%), media experts (98%), and user responses (87%). Thus, the Answer and Jump game is feasible to use, but needs further testing on wider and more diverse groups.
