

## ABSTRACT

*School-aged children are vulnerable to injury due to active physical activity in accordance with their level of physical, motor, cognitive and psychosocial development. Emergency events often occur suddenly and unexpectedly, including in the school environment. Therefore, education regarding first aid is very important, especially through demonstration methods that can increase experience and memory. This study aims to determine the effect of the first aid demonstration method for wound care on the knowledge, and skills of members of the Youth Red Cross (PMR) MAN 1 Malang. The research method used was Pre-Experimental with a one group pre-test post-test design. The research sample consisted of 30 members of PMR MAN 1 Malang who were selected using total sampling techniques. The research instrument is a questionnaire to measure knowledge and a checklist for skills. The statistical test used is the Wilcoxon signed ranks test with a significance level of  $\alpha = 0.05$ . The statistical test results show a P-value of 0.000, which means the P-value  $< 0.05$ , so  $H_0$  is rejected and  $H_1$  is accepted. The research results showed that there was a significant difference in the pre-test scores (mean = 6.33) and post-test (mean = 8.80), which indicated a positive influence of the first aid demonstration method on increasing the knowledge and skills of PMR MAN 1 Malang members.*
