

ABSTRACT

Marriage carried out by adolescents affects the high birth rate, women who marry under the age of < 20 years have a longer reproductive span so it is advisable to use contraceptives. One of the efforts to increase the scope of contraceptive use is husband support. This study aims to determine the picture of husband support in the use of contraceptive methods in women with a history of early marriage. The design of this study is quantitative descriptive with a survey approach, samples were taken by Purposive sampling of 40 people who are active family planning acceptors in Klampok Village, Singosari District, Malang Regency. Data collection using Questionnaire. The data was analyzed descriptively with the results, showing that 45.0% of respondents had husbands who supported birth control, while 55.0% of respondents had husbands who did not support birth control. Husbands who are not emotionally supportive show less form of attention, husbands do not advise not to be anxious about overcoming the side effects of birth control. Husbands who are not instrumental supportive are shown to lack participation in accompanying mothers during birth control counseling. The conclusion of this study shows that husband's support in the use of contraceptive methods in Klampok Village is still lacking. Midwives and family planning field officers (PLKB) are expected to involve their husbands during counseling for repeat visits to family planning services in order to increase the number of family planning acceptors.
