Clean and healthy living behavior (PHBS) in the school environment is an effort by students and teachers on the basis of awareness to prevent disease, create a healthy environment free of disease, and improve the quality of health for the body. Follow-up efforts as an increase in knowledge and attitudes of teachers and students to improve these indicators. The success of a student in implementing PHBS in the school environment is inseparable from the actions and attitudes of the teacher who are exemplary for their students. The purpose of this study was to determine the relationship between the teacher's role and knowledge and attitudes about clean and healthy living behavior in grade 4 students at Ngemplakrejo Elementary School, Pasuruan City. The research design is correlational analysis with a sectional Ross approach. The population is 25 students. The sampling technique is total sampling with a sample of 25 students. Data analysis used Spearman's test with $p = 0.05$, the results showed that the relationship between the teacher's role and knowledge about PHBS in grade 4 students of SD Ngemplakrejo with $p = 0.000$ and there was no relationship between the role of the teacher and attitudes about PHBS in grade 4 SD Ngemplakrejo with $p = 0.480$. For this reason, it is hoped that the Ngemplakrejo Public Elementary School, Pasuruan City, can continue to improve and develop Clean and Healthy Behavior activities properly and correctly.
