Abstract

Stunting is a chronic malnutrition problem caused by a lack of nutritional intake/a condition of physical failure in toddlers as measured by height for age (TB/U). Indonesia is ranked fifth in the world. In 2022 the total number of toddlers experiencing stunting was 82 in the working area of the Kedungwaru Health Center, Tulungagung Regency. Kedungwaru village has a total of 11 stunted toddlers. This study aims to determine the role of the team in accelerating the reduction of stunting in the program for handling stunting in toddlers in Kedungwaru village, Tulungagung district. This type of research used quantitative research with cross sectional design. The technique used in this research uses total sampling technique. The population is the whole of the research object which is the center of attention and research data source. The sampling technique used was a total sampling of 20 respondents. Data collection techniques using a questionnaire instrument. The results of the study found that there was a team role in accelerating stunting reduction in the stunt management program in Kedungwaru village, with a p value of $0.043 \leq 0.05$. 12 respondents (60%) had a positive/supportive attitude, while 10 respondents (50%) played a good role.
