Description of The Knowledge of Informal Sector Workers Regarding Participation in The National Health Insurance in Pagak Village, Malang District, Sinta Adelia Putri (2023) Final Project Report, Department of Applied Health, Health Polytechnic Ministry of Health Malang, Advisor AA Istri Ayu Tyas Purnamasari, SKM. The Indonesian government has implemented the JKN program organized by the National Health Organizing Agency (BPJS). Preliminary studies have been conducted from 70 informal sector workers in Pagak village, there are 45 people who do not take JKN. It can be seen that the majority of informal sector workers in Pagak village are not included in the Mandiri Health BPJS participants. The purpose of this study is to describe the knowledge of informal sector workers regarding JKN participation in Pagak village, Malang district. This study uses a quantitative descriptive with a cross sectional approach. Performed on 44 respondents who are informal sector workers in the village of Pagak and the variables include knowledge, employment, education and age. The results of this study were that 25 respondents (56.8%) had a level of knowledge in the 'low' category, 19 people (43.2%) were in the 'good' category. The characteristics of the majority of respondents aged 26-45 years were 17 people (38.6%), the most gender was male, namely 25 people (56.8%), with basic education levels, namely not going to school, graduating from elementary school, graduating from junior high school. 31 people (70.5%) and the majority of the work is their own business as many as 16 people (36.4%). Conclusion: Most of the informal sector workers in Pagak village have little knowledge about JKN participation and do not participate in JKN. Suggestion: increase socialization by JKN cadres, and hold visits between BPJS Health officers and residents to Pagak village so that the community can access more information from the socialization provided.
