

ABSTRACT

Descriptive Study of Predisposing Factor and reinforcing factor in Non-Active PBPU Participants in the National Health Insurance Program in Kedungpandan Jabon Village, Sidoarjo Regency. 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The National Health Insurance is a program organized with the aim of fulfilling the basic needs of public health which is provided to everyone who has paid contributions or whose contributions have been paid by the Government, however, based on a preliminary study, it was found that as many as 48.3% of PBPU participants who were registered as JKN participants had non-active membership status. The purpose of this study was to determine the level of education, knowledge, employment, income, motivation, and perceptions of non-active PBPU participants. This type of research is descriptive quantitative. The sample in this study were 72 respondents. Data analysis using univariate analysis. The results of the analysis of non-active PBPU participants showed that there were 6 variables in this study, namely, the majority of non-active PBPU participants in Kedungpandan Village had a secondary level of education (61.1%), almost all non-active PBPU participants had low knowledge (81.94%), Most of the non-active PBPU participants are working (68.05%), the majority of non-active PBPU participants' income is low (97.2%), most of the PBPU participants' motivation is non -active is low (52.7%), and most of the non-active PBPU participants have a negative perception of JKN (54.16%).
