

## ABSTRACT

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*:Inhibiting Factors the Implementation Based Daily Inpatient Census at Masyithoh Islamic Hospital Bangil*

*Implementation of a good medical record will support the improvement of health services in a hospital. One of the supports is the preparation of hospital statistical reports based on the daily census of hospitalizations. At RSI Masyithoh, it is known that the implementation of the daily census process for inpatient care is often delayed. The delay was that the daily census was returned not on time so that the results of the recapitulation to the reporting department were delayed so that the hospital's monthly reports were not completed on time. This study aims to analyze the factors inhibiting the daily census process by determining the root causes of the problem using a fishbone diagram. This type of research uses qualitative research conducted in January-April 2023. Data was collected by observation, interviews and documentation. The subjects of this study were three room nurses and one medical record officer reporting section. The results of this study indicate that the factors causing the delay in the daily census of inpatient care are man factors, namely the high workload of officers and the lack of a sense of responsibility of officers. The material factor is the absence of a daily census SIMRS so that the implementation is still using the manual method with an SHRI sheet. The money factor is the lack of funding for socializing officers, providing facilities, and rewarding officers. Then the method factor, namely SOP is not well socialized. To overcome this, it is hoped that an analysis of the workload of officers and dissemination of SOPs to daily census officers can be carried out.*
