The accuracy of disease coding is still not in accordance with the rules of ICD-10 because it is difficult to read the doctor's diagnosis. The lack of specificity in writing the code usually occurs in the 4th digit code because the complete diagnosis is not written. On the medical resume sheet of inpatients at Lavalette Hospital in 2022, there is an inaccuracy in writing the code for the diagnosis of patients with cervical cancer, namely only 3 digit code C53. This study aims to identify the accuracy of codefication of cervical cancer based on ICD-10 in medical resume inpatient Lavalette Hospital. This study uses a quantitative descriptive method. In this study, the population will be all medical record documents at the gynecology polyclinic in the second quarter, totaling 1,605 medical record documents and medical record officers as informants who will be interviewed to obtain data and information during the study. The sampel in this study was calculated using the slovin formula, namely as many as 94 medical record documents. The sampling technique uses simple random sampling technique. Data analysis using univariate analysis. The results showed that 86% of the cervical cancer codes were correct and 14% of the cervical cancer codes were incorrect because they did not use the 4th digit code. So it can be concluded that there are cervical cancer codes that are not used correctly according to ICD-10.
