

ABSTRACT

In order to increase the fairness of services based on the principle of equity that must be obtained by all JKN participants, the government is trying to implement standard inpatient classes (KRIS-JKN). In accordance with Government Regulation Number 47 of 2021 concerning Implementation of the Hospital Sector, standard inpatient classes will be held no later than January 1, 2023. The purpose of this study is to determine the preparation of Class B Hospitals in Probolinggo City in facing the implementation of KRIS JKN in fulfilling medical devices (nightstand, density and quality of TT), utility systems (electrical contact boxes, nurse call/nurse bell, oxygen outlets, ventilation, temperature control, and lighting), and hospital facilities (components/hospital buildings, bathrooms in inpatient rooms, rooms hospitalization, curtain/partition). This research is a case study research with a qualitative approach. The sampling technique used in this study is non-probability sampling, namely purposive sampling. The result of this research is the preparation of RSUD Dr. Mohamad Saleh in the implementation of the JKN standard inpatient class on fulfilling medical devices is carried out by transferring to a new ward to meet the TT density criteria, on fulfilling the hospital utility system especially temperature regulation and nurse calls will be fulfilled in the near future, on fulfilling hospital facilities especially building components and bathrooms in the treatment room will be fulfilled and budgeted for in stages. The conclusion in this study is based on 12 predetermined criteria, RSUD Dr. Mohamad Saleh Probolinggo City has met the criteria of 60%.
