

## **ABSTRACT**

*Medical records are part of archives that describe all activities of a health care facility within a certain period of time. Community knowledge is a process in which a person tries to sense a particular object. The purpose of this study was to determine the confidentiality of medical records, access rights to medical records and the use of medical records. The most important thing for this purpose is to socialize the level of public knowledge about medical records. This type of research uses experimental research methods with a pre-experimental one group pre-test-posttest design. The population in this study amounted to 25 people with junior and senior high school education backgrounds. The sample in this study is a saturated sample in which the total population is used in this sample, namely 25 junior high and high school youth with an age range of 14-20 years in RT 06 RW 02 Tunjungsekar Village, Besukkidul Village, Lowokwaru District. The results of the study after socialization were that the level of public knowledge about the confidentiality of medical records was very good with a percentage of 100%, the level of knowledge about access rights to medical records was very good with a percentage of 92% and the level of public knowledge about the use of medical records was very good with a percentage of 72%.*
