According to Permenkes No. 24 Article 3 of 2022 it is explained that every Health Service Facility is obliged to organize Electronic Medical Records. Electronic Medical Record (RME) records personal health information in electronic form in an integrated manner managed by one or more health workers at each meeting. This study aims to determine the readiness to face RME. The research design was descriptive qualitative with an analysis of the 5M method (Man, Machine, Method, Material and Money). The population consisted of 3 medical record officers so that the total sampling technique was used. The results of the study were 12 officers who had met the D-3 RMIK education standard and were able to carry out RME even though they had never attended RME implementation training. RSUD Daha Husada Kediri uses paper and electronic medical records, the machine is sufficient to carry out the implementation of RME, there is no SOP for the implementation of RME and there is no guidebook for implementing RME and the hospital has budgeted for the implementation of RME. The conclusion from the results obtained, Daha Husada Kediri Hospital is ready to do RME and it is recommended that before implementing RME, a guidebook and SOP for implementing RME are equipped.
