

## **ABSTRACT**

**Background:** *The high birth rate and low utilization of postpartum contraception remain challenges in Indonesia. One recommended method is the Intrauterine Device (IUD), known for its high effectiveness and long-term protection. However, postpartum IUD usage remains low due to misinformation, fear, and misconceptions. **Objective:** This case study aims to describe midwifery care for a postpartum IUD acceptor in the interval period at TPMB Mamik Yulaikah, S.Tr.Keb, Bululawang – Malang Regency. **Method:** The study used a descriptive case study approach involving a postpartum woman opting for IUD contraception during the interval period ( $\geq 4$  weeks after delivery). Data were collected through observation, interviews, and documentation covering assessment, diagnosis, intervention, implementation, and evaluation. **Results:** The client met all criteria for IUD insertion, showed no contraindications, and had adequate family support. Comprehensive midwifery care was provided following service standards, including education, tool preparation, aseptic insertion technique, and post-insertion follow-up. The client reported no complaints and showed improved understanding of the IUD method. **Conclusion:** Proper and standard-based midwifery care can improve understanding, comfort, and success of postpartum IUD use in the interval period. Effective counseling and professional service are key to increasing IUD acceptor coverage.*
