

## ABSTRACT

The incidence of abortion in Indonesia remains quite high and is a leading cause of maternal mortality. Data from the Ministry of Health in 2023 stated that approximately 4.7%–13.2% of maternal deaths were caused by abortion. A preliminary study at the As Syifa Husada Clinic in Poncokusumo showed that 7 out of 20 pregnant women experienced abortions at <20 weeks of gestation. The purpose of this case study is to describe midwifery care for pregnant women with threatened abortion. The method used was a case study with a descriptive exploratory approach. The subject was a 42-year-old pregnant woman with a gestational age of 10–12 weeks who experienced light bleeding. Care was provided using Varney's 7-step midwifery management approach. The results showed that the mother's condition improved after bed rest, education, monitoring of vital signs, and collaboration with doctors for ultrasound examinations and supportive therapy. The conclusion of this study is that rapid and appropriate midwifery care can prevent complications and maintain pregnancy in cases of threatened abortion.
