

ABSTRACT

Background: *The management of food at the Arhanud Education Center Dormitory in Batu City, the level of knowledge and attitudes related to hygiene and sanitation, and the lack of training for food handlers regarding hygiene and sanitation. Objective:* This study aims to analyze the level of knowledge and attitudes regarding hygiene and sanitation among food handlers at the Arhanud Education Center Dormitory in Batu City. **Method:** This type of research is quantitative with a descriptive research design. The study was conducted at the Arhanud Education Center Dormitory in Batu City. The subjects of this research consisted of 10 food handlers. Data collection was carried out by administering pre-tests and post-tests to assess the knowledge and attitudes of the food handlers. **Results:** Based on the analyzed data, it was found that hygiene and sanitation education significantly influenced the knowledge and attitudes of food handlers, as evidenced by an increase in scores from pre-tests to post-tests regarding their knowledge and attitudes. **Conclusion:** The level of knowledge and attitudes among food handlers was categorized as poor before receiving education on hygiene and sanitation; most food handlers at the Arhanud Education Center did not wear complete personal protective equipment (PPE) while working. **Keywords:** Food Management, Hygiene and Sanitation, Food Handler
