

# **FAMILY SUPPORT IN DRUG COMPLIANCE WITH PULMONARY TUBERCULOSIS PATIENTS IN PUSKESMAS JANTI**

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## **ABSTRACT**

Pulmonary tuberculosis remains a worldwide health problem. Pulmonary tuberculosis is a chronic disease and is infectious through droplets into the air. The treatment and cure of this disease is also influenced by the factor of drug compliance, which is still a public health problem in Indonesia and the world. The purpose of this case study is to provide family support in adherence to taking medication in pulmonary tuberculosis patients in the form of family nursing care. The research method used in this case study is descriptive by describing the medical experience and nursing care of the patient. Based on the results of the case study, the problem of Noncompliance and Ineffective Family Health Management was obtained by providing educational interventions for Pulmonary tuberculosis care. Implementation carried out during 3 days of home visits obtained an evaluation of the results that the Pulmonary tuberculosis care education provided can increase compliance with taking medication and family support in the treatment of Pulmonary tuberculosis. It is hoped that the non-pharmacological action of providing Pulmonary tuberculosis care education can be one of the options in increasing compliance and family motivation in patients with Pulmonary tuberculosis.
