ABSTRACT

Mother's knowledge about breastfeeding will affect the success of mothers in breastfeeding. The purpose of knowing the relationship between knowledge of breastfeeding mothers and lactation management in infants aged 0-6 months at Posyandu Anyelir, Wringinanom Village, Situbondo Regency. The design of this study used a non-experimental quantitative descriptive method with a cross-sectional correlation approach. The study population was 35 breastfeeding mothers. The sampling method used purposive sampling by taking according to the inclusion criteria, the results obtained were respondents who had good knowledge. The conclusion of this study is that it has been described that there is a relationship between knowledge of breastfeeding mothers and lactation management in infants aged 0-6 months with a p value of 0.002. It is hoped that health workers can provide education to breastfeeding mothers to increase knowledge of breastfeeding mothers and lactation in infants aged 0-6 months.
