

ABSTRACT

[Analysis of Completeness of Informed Consent Filling for Sectio Caesarea Action at RSIA X Malang City]. [R.B. Informed Consent is an agreement regarding the medical action that will be carried out by a doctor on his patient. Incomplete filling of informed consent can be detrimental to patients, doctors or hospitals because the informed consent form will be weak in terms of law. The purpose of this study was to determine the completeness of filling out the informed consent for caesarean section actions at RSIA X Malang City for the period January - July 2024. This type of research is quantitative descriptive and data collection techniques by means of observation. The sample used was calculated using the slovin formula and using a simple random sampling technique by taking it randomly from a population. The results of the study of 73 forms of informed consent for caesarean section procedures, the average completeness of filling in important reporting components (0.97) and standard deviation value (0.16), the average completeness of filling in important reporting components (0.85) and standard deviation value (0.36), the average completeness of filling in authentication components (0.95) and standard deviation value (0.23), the average completeness of filling in documentation components (0.84) and standard deviation value (0.37), and the results of the completeness of filling in the form of informed consent for caesarean section procedures as a whole obtained an average value (0.74) and standard deviation value (0.44) overall the level of completeness of filling in informed consent for caesarean section procedures has not reached 100%.
